BY-LAW NO.1826

**Being a By-Law to endorse the
Deputy Clerk to solemnize civil
marriages and to establish the fee
for service.**

WHEREAS Ontario Regulation 738, as amended, made under the Marriage Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.M.3, as amended, authorizes the Deputy Clerk of the Township of Hornepayne to solemnize marriages under the authority of a license (O. Reg. 285/04), s.1; and,

WHEREAS the Council for the Township of Hornepayne deems it desirable to provide civil marriage solemnization services;

THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HORNEPAYNE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Council hereby directs that the civil marriage solemnization service be implemented;
2. That Shannon Milley, Deputy Clerk, be and is hereby authorized to solemnize marriages in the Province of Ontario, as authorized by Regulation 738, as amended, made under the Marriage Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M.3, as amended;
3. That Shannon Milley may, at her discretion, solemnize civil marriages at times and locations agreeable to both parties;
4. That Council recognizes that the Deputy Clerk shall have the authority to delegate other qualified persons the authority to solemnize civil marriages;
5. That the conduct of civil marriage ceremonies shall be performed in accordance with the Civil Marriage Solemnization Policy for the Township of Hornepayne;
6. That the fees for services shall be as outlined in the Comprehensive User Fee By-Law No. 1825 or as amended.
7. That the provisions of this By-Law shall come into full force and effect upon passing and the Deputy Clerk shall take all steps necessary to implement.
